Note: (1)Other cases include investigation/other cases, forensic examination, petition cases, retrieval of files and review of judgement, implementing prosecutions, reconsideration, probation, etc.
(2)Prosecution of investigation cases concluded includes public prosecution of regular proceeding and motion for summary judgment. Others include transfer to mediation, a circular order, transfer of jurisdiction, transfer to the court for joint trial, drug cases transfer to a rehab institution, transfer to private prosecution and administrative closure of cases.
